Over 25 years of touring, Emilie-Claire has performed all over the world, including countless festivals, theatres, clubs, and private concerts from trio to 65-piece orchestra, featuring repertoire from her impressive catalogue of 13 albums. She has amassed over 450 million streams across platforms, with *Seule ce soir* (her all-French album) and *The Beat Goes On* (reimagining songs of the 1960s) being among the most popular.

Her live performances showcase her inspired re-imaginings and affectionate treatments of classic pop and jazz songs, bossa novas, and French chanson delivered with a relaxed, polished demeanor, charming humour, and a voice of unforgettable beauty.

Winter Wonderland: Emilie-Claire and her stellar band present fresh interpretations of holiday classics and lesser-known gems in this special holiday concert at Koerner Hall. Taking repertoire from her two seasonal albums, *Winter Wonderland* and *Lumières d'hiver*, Emilie-Claire's voice breathes new life into timeless, familiar melodies, and introduces new original repertoire.
